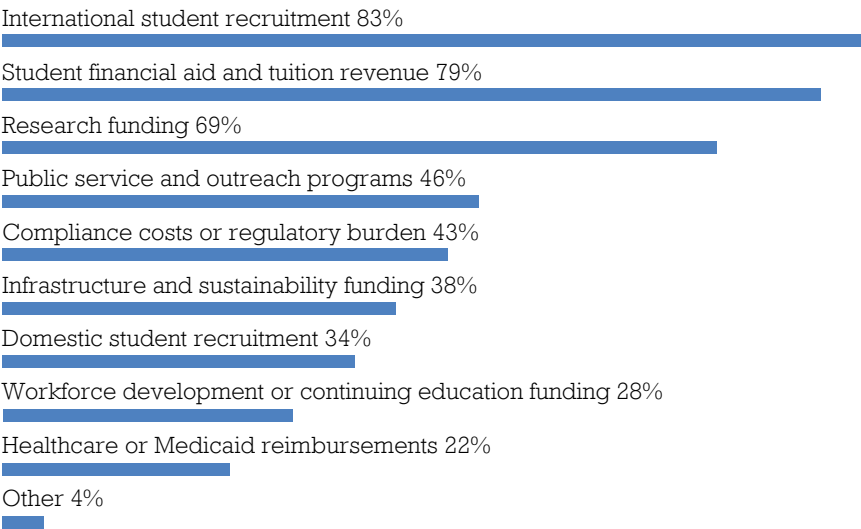

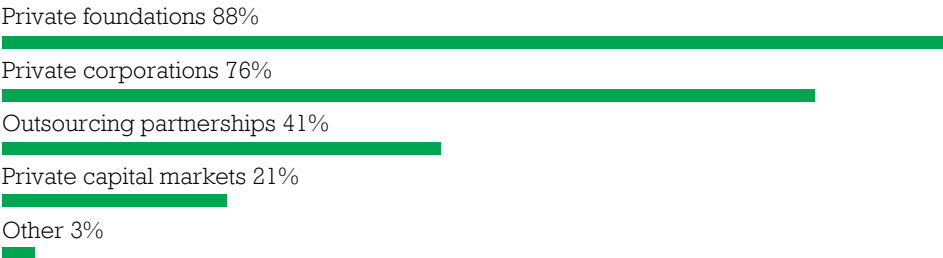

DO YOU BELIEVE THE PRIVATE SECTOR IS A POTENTIAL SOURCE TO REPLACE ANY LOST REVENUE?



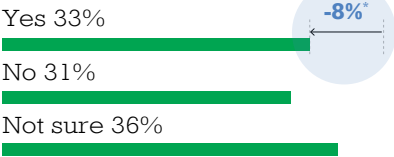

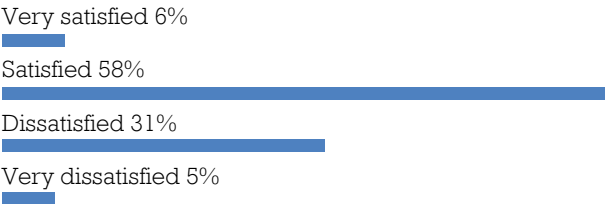

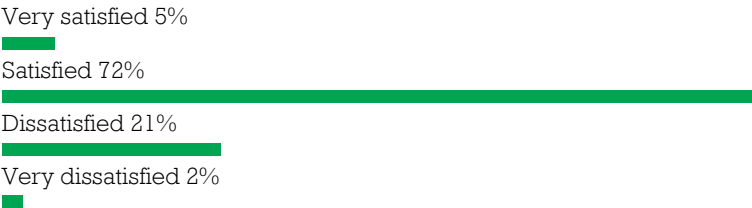
Revenue-Share vs. Fee-For-Service

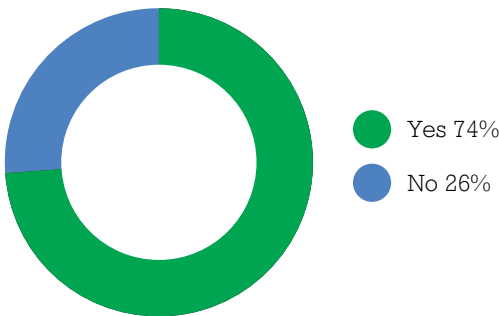

YOUR CAMPUS?



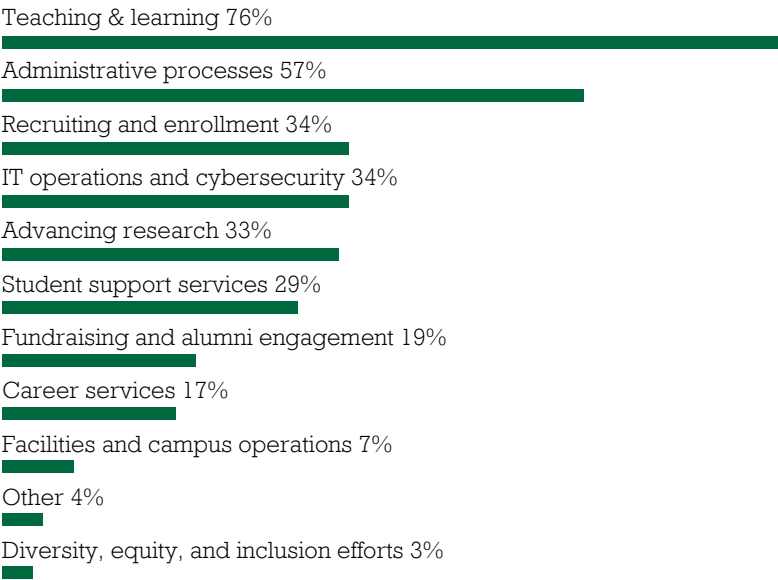

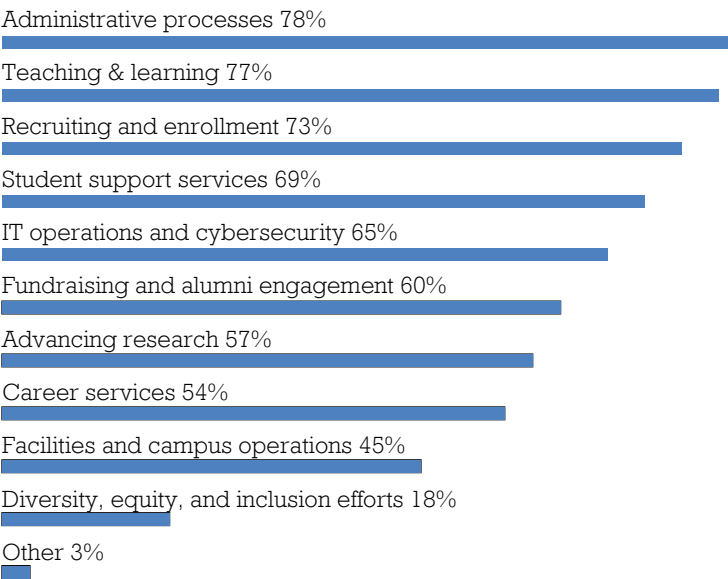

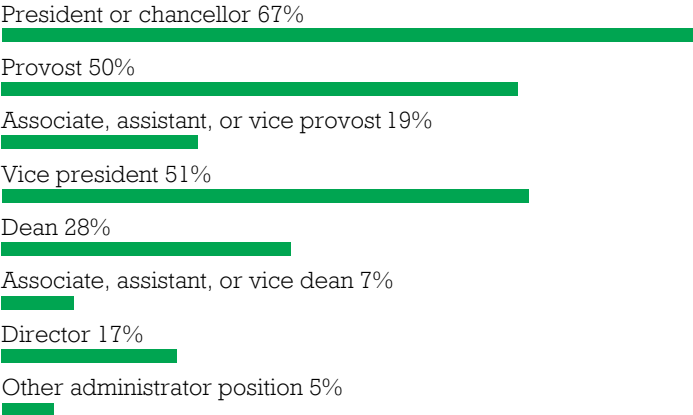

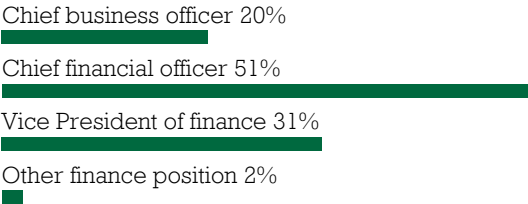

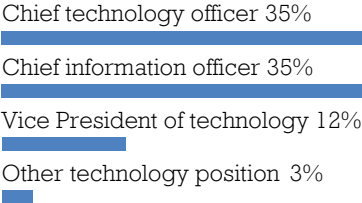

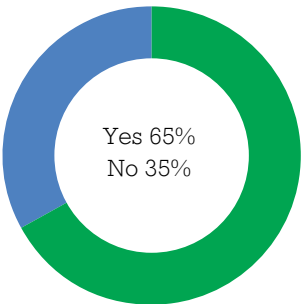
